

## **Project Commissioner - Position Description**

### **Rover Centenary**

Branch Rover Councils are asked to appoint a Rover to coordinate the implementation of the 2018 Rover Centennial program as a project officer of their BRC. The BRC Centenary Project Officer will work with the NRC Rover Centenary working group to:

- ❖ Update BRC about upcoming NRC Rover Centenary program initiatives
- ❖ Coordinate Rover Centenary program at a branch level
- ❖ Report BRC progress to NRC Rover Centenary working group chairman
- ❖ Liaise and negotiate with NRC Rover Centenary working group about issues relating to their respective branch Rovering program
- ❖ Encourage the SA Rovers to actively participate in the Rover Centenary

NRC Rover Centenary Officers will be required to attend and report at BRC Centenary Project Officer meetings and may be asked to attend NRC Rover Centenary working group meetings. These meetings will be facilitated by the NRC Rover Centenary working group chair using online meeting platform Go-To-Meeting.

BRC Rover Centenary Project Officers should be passionate about Rovering, with a keen interest in developing connections with Rovers in their branch, former Rovers, including Rover fellowships and guilds, and the wider community to promote the 2018 Rover Centenary. Rover Basic Training is recommended, but not required for this position.

BRC Chairs and/or BRC Rover Centenary Officers may choose to create a BRC Rover Centenary Team under the BRC Rover Centenary Project Officer. This team may include, but is not limited to, a Moot100 coordinator, Service100 coordinator, Link100 coordinator, and Media and Promotions Officer.
