What is Sandblast?

Sandblast is a long weekend Rover Moot activity, with a range of expeditions and activities suitable for Rovers and Venturer Scouts. Sandblast is operated by the Sandblast Committee of the Rover Scout Section of South Australia.

How do I get to Sandblast?

Sandblast is held at 202 Martin Road, Wall Flat, South Australia (which can be found on Google Maps).

Sandblast is a convenient 15 minutes from Mannum, and 1 hour from Adelaide. The easiest way to Sandblast from Adelaide is via the South Eastern Freeway.

Participant Expectations and Responsibilities

As a Participant, it is an expectation that both you and your Crew/Unit work together with the committee, staff and other participants to create a safe environment for Sandblast. This is to ensure that incidents are dealt with appropriately and risks are mitigated before any issues occur.

Please report incidents and risks to Admin, who will further inform the relevant Committee members.

General site rules

- Sandblast is a pedestrian area and as such the speed limit for vehicles traveling through the site is 5km/h.
- No cars, trailers or caravans shall remain in the campsite over the course of the event. They must be parked in the designated carpark.
- All rubbish **MUST** be removed and disposed of by the Crew or Unit.
- Crews/Units must have their campsite inspected before their final departure from site.
- All participants are responsible to adhering to the Code of Conduct, Scouts Australia Policy and Rules, South Australian Rover Policies, and the National Rover Council's Alcohol Guidelines.

Camping at Sandblast

Sandblast is a self-sufficient camp, which requires crews/units to **provide their own camping and catering**. Crews may offer to cater for other crews, so keep an eye out for the offer and details.

- Rover and Venturer Campsites are separated - Venturers are **strictly** prohibited from entering the Rover Campsite.
- Only Venturers, Venturer Leaders and Committee Members are permitted into the Venturer Campsite. Site maps and further camping details will be available prior to the event.

Fire Safety

- Smoking - participants wishing to smoke should only do so in designated smoking areas and all cigarette butts disposed of in the designated bins. Please see the Sandblast Site Map (Provided to you at the gate upon entry) for the smoking locations. Smoking must be done away from Youth Members.
- Spare fuel sources including, but not limited to, gas cylinders and jerry cans must be at least 5 meters from any operating appliance. Cylinders in active supply of gas (E.G.: next to a BBQ while you are using it) are exempt from the 5-metre rule
- Inspect all hoses and fittings for possible damage from transit or improper storage before any equipment is used.

Welfare

- All participants are expected to look out for your fellow Rovers, Venturers, Leaders and Guests. If a participant requires medical attention or other assistance, please assist them to Admin or the nearest Committee Member.
- Every participant or staff member onsite must be associated with a Rover Crew, Venturer Unit, or be an invited guest. Interstate visitors must be associated with a contingent, and a contingent leader must be appointed for the duration of the event.

Emergencies

- A First Aider will be present at Admin during the event.
- In the event of an emergency, Crew Leaders/Venturer Leaders are to gather all their Crew Members/Venturers at the Admin Office and account for them. If a full site evacuation is required, the Sandblast Committee will direct participants to evacuate to the Wall Flat Hall (located nearby).

Venturers

- Venturers are welcome to attend Sandblast and will be provided their own campsite area.
- Venturers may have a leader attend with them, but a Venturer Leader is provided for the Venturers during the event.
- Venturers are welcome from Friday 28th until the afternoon of Sunday 30th September at 3pm.

Drinking

- Drinking is permitted at Sandblast in the Rover Camp.
- The Entertainment Area will be a dry zone for a specified period time, in which drinking will be prohibited.
- Alcohol consumption is strictly prohibited in front and near Youth Members.
- Youth Members are prohibited from the Entertainment Area during the designated consumption time and Rover Camp at all times.

Other Questions/Answers

Activities/Schedule

The Event Schedule will be available from the Sandblast Website (sarovers.com.au/sandblast) closer to the event, and from Admin during the event.

Updates and Information

We will use your registration details to contact you regarding the event and inform you of changes to the schedule and emergencies. Please ensure that your contact information is correct.

Competitions

Sandblast holds several competitions over the duration of the weekend, including Grandpa's Cup, which is a campsite and cooking competition.

Further information will be provided before the event, and registrations for judging will be available at Admin during the event.

What services are provided onsite at Sandblast?

Sandblast provides several onsite services to make your stay with us more enjoyable. These include:

- Event Admin and First Aid
- Entertainment Area
- Day time activities
- Nightly entertainment
- Toilets
 - Showers are based nearby at the Wall Flat Hall (corner Martin Road and Starr Road, Wall Flat). The hall key is available upon request from Admin.

Mobile Reception at the Sandblast Site

Mobile reception is limited/patchy at the Sandblast site, depending on your provider.

How do I buy my Sandblast ticket?

Tickets are now available through events.sarovers.com.au until midnight on the 21st September 2018. After that, tickets can be purchased at the event gate at the Gate Ticket cost of \$50 in Cash only.
